Georg Ebersbach, M.D. is director of the Movement Disorders Clinic Beelitz-Heilstätten, Germany, since 1998. He received medical training in the university clinics of Berlin and Innsbruck, Austria. Research fellowships led him to Baylor College, Houston, USA and Hospital Clinic, Barcelona, Spain. He is associate professor for clinical neurology at the University Hospital Charité, Berlin and for Sports Neurology at the University of Potsdam. He was secretary of the German Parkinson's disease Society (Deutsche Parkinson Gesellschaft) from 2011-2017 and President of the German Parkinson Congress in 2015. He was awarded the Federal Service Cross in 2019.

Currently he is member of the executive board of the German Parkinson Foundation. He has published numerous peer-reviewed articles and reviews on different clinical aspects of Parkinson's disease and other movement disorders. Main topics of his research are disturbances of gait and posture in PD, multidisciplinary therapy in PD and non-motor symptoms in PD.
